(the "Contest")

OFFICIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Contest is intended for viewing and participation in Canada only by legal residents of Canada, who have attained the age of majority in the province in which they reside, and shall be subject to and construed in accordance with the laws of Canada. Please do not proceed if you do not satisfy these requirements at the time of entry. Entry into the Contest constitutes your acceptance to these Official Rules and Regulations.

- 1) **CONTEST ADMINISTRATION:** The Contest is administered and operated by Boston Pizza International Inc. ("**Contest Operator**"). The Contest Operator is not responsible for lost or late entries or entries that have been tampered. All decisions of the Contest Operator shall be final and shall not be subject to appeal.
